

I would highly recommend IAG to any family considering adoption. I began my adoption journey two years prior to coming to IAG and bringing my son home. I had previously been working with another agency, adopting a child through Guatemala when that country closed to international adoptions. That agency was not working with any countries that allowed single mothers to adopt, so I began exploring other options. Prior to contacting any agencies I did extensive research on the agencies, narrowing it down to two agencies. Having worked in the foster care system for 10 years, I was absolutely thrilled to learn that Mary Mooney was the Executive Director. When I contacted IAG I found the staff to be well informed, educated in the area of international adoptions, open to all my questions and inquiries. Once I had decided on IAG and was ready to begin the process, they sent me a waiting child's list and I found my son there. I believe it was God directed and my son had been waiting for me to find him. I officially accepted my son's referral in June of 2009 and brought him home December 25, 2009.

During this entire process, the staff at IAG were quick to respond to any questions or concerns I had. They were always upfront and honest about the process, what to expect and not expect. Cost estimates were accurate, almost to the dollar. The staff is committed to providing quality care to the children, and takes a hands on approach. They are also committed to humanitarian efforts. Even after 5 months of being home, the staff shows an interest in my family. If I decide to adopt again, there is no doubt what agency I will use.
